PARENTS BILL OF RIGHTS

Under New York state law, if you are a parent of a child in the New York City public school district (the DOE), you have the following rights regarding the privacy and security of your child's PII:

Data protection:

• Your child's personally identifiable information cannot be sold or released for any marketing or other commercial purposes.

Data Access:

• You have the right to inspect and review the complete contents of your child's education records

Confidentiality

• We adhere to state and federal laws to protect the confidentiality of your child's personally identifiable information. Robust safeguards like encryption, firewalls, and password protection are in place for data storage and transfer. Third-party contractors we work with also follow the National Institute of Standards and Technology Cybersecurity Framework.

Data Breach Notification:

• In the event of a data breach or unauthorized disclosure of students' personally identifiable information, third-party contractors are legally required to notify JCC/First Foot Forward within seven (7) days of discovery.

Supplemental Information:

• If JCC/ First Foot Forward Preschool shares student, teacher, or principal data with a third party under a contract, we will append supplemental information for each such contract to this Parents' Bill of Rights.
